### All Schools Program

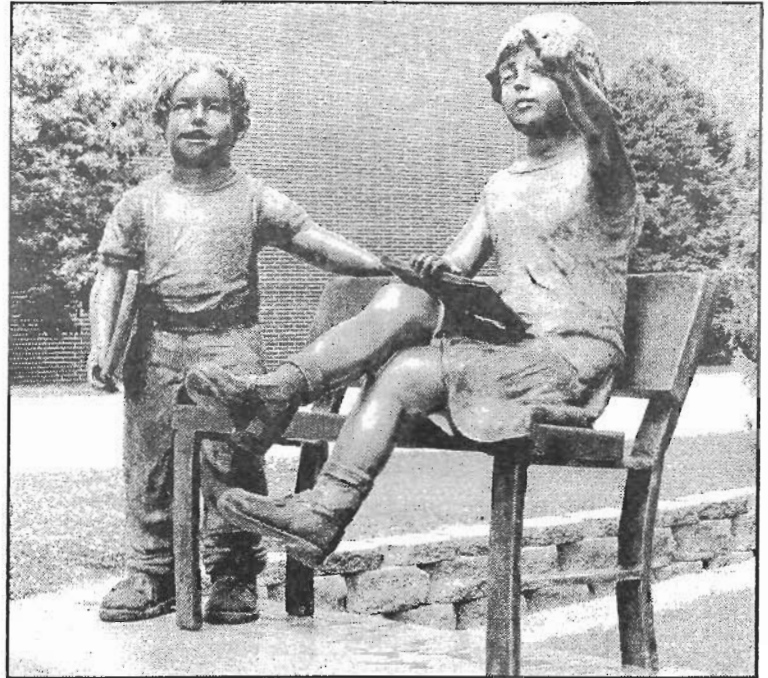

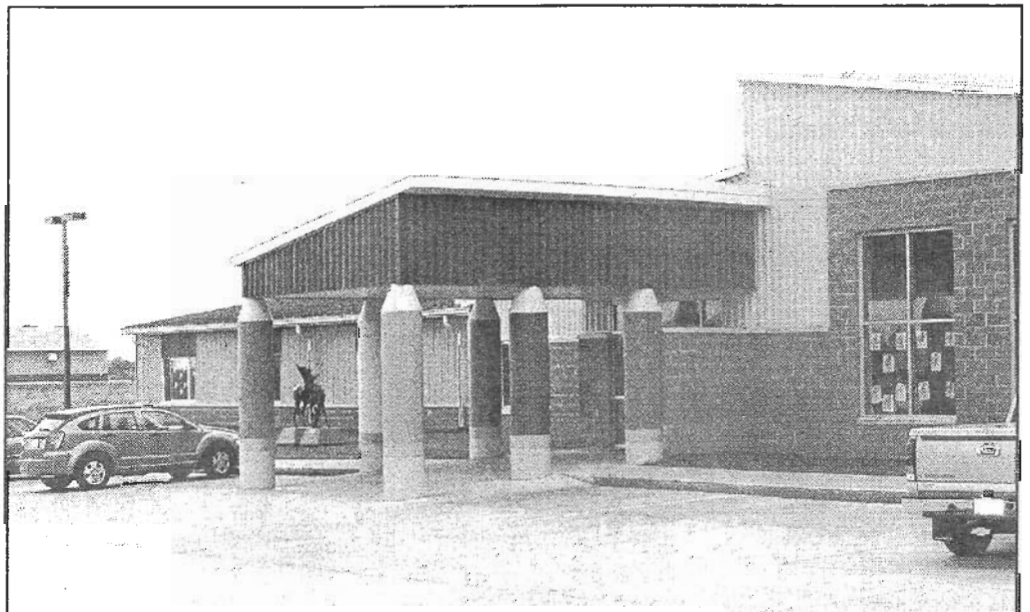
